HOW TO HANDLE THE WAX CAPPINGS:

THE DAKOTA GUNNESS UNCAPPERS have been used successfully with every kind of wax handling system: spinners, melters and skimming, without major changes in the honey house. More than likely, the uncapper can be adapted to your present system with few changes. The uncapper is no longer the "bottle neck" of the honey house. You can determine how many barrels a day you want to do, up to 60 barrels a day with one DAKOTA GUNNESS UNCAPPER.

IMPROVED FEATURES OF 200 MODEL:

The up and down positions of the flails may be quickly changed with hand nut turning while the machine is in use. This helps when combs are unevenly filled.

The uncapper is also equipped with 2 electric switches so that the flails can be stopped if the combs are relatively empty, while you run the combs through the conveyer to the extractor.

A new baffle helps to eliminate splatters.
